

**Memorandum of Agreement
Between
The Department of Juvenile Justice and The DeSoto County Sheriff's Office**

Whereas the State of Florida, Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) and the DeSoto County Sheriff's Office (DCSO) seek to promote the objective that State and Local Governments support each others efforts in providing the highest level of services available to the public through cooperation and sharing of public assets when feasible.

There are no financial obligations between the parties of this agreement unless specifically outlined in the agreement.

Therefore both parties agree to cooperate in the providing of realistic situational training environments:

Property and facilities located at 5847 SE Highway 31 Arcadia, Florida 34266:

Facilities to be utilized:

- Staff Residential Buildings 5758 5779 5799 5807 5809 5906
- Old Motel Building
- Old Hospital E368
- Miscellaneous Revere Olivewood Kennedy Azelwood

The DeSoto County Sheriff's Office will:

- Provide a designated person(s) and their contact information to facilitate the communication between the DCSO and the DJJ in regards to this agreement.
- Hold the DJJ harmless for activities related to training of members of the DCSO.
- Provide to the DJJ representative the following in writing either by fax or email:
 - Quarterly a list of dates, times and buildings to be utilized for training.
 - Quarterly a list of commanders and or supervisors who may be observing training for that period.
 - A week in advance of the specified training a list of all DCSO members who will be participating in the training along with specific types of equipment being utilized for the training.
 - The day prior to training notify the facility security representative.
- Video record the condition of the property and or facility to be used on the date of the training prior to and immediately following the training.
- Only conduct simulation training and at no time will live ammunition or other destructive ordinance be utilized on the property.
- Make every effort to leave the property and facilities as it was found prior to the training.
- Immediately notify the DJJ representative of any damage caused to the property or facilities by DCSO members.
- Repair, replace or reimburse, at fair market value, the DJJ for any damages at the DJJ's discretion.
- Notify the DJJ when the agreement is no longer desired or needed for training purposes.

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The Department of Juvenile Justice will:

- Provide a designated person(s) and their contact information to facilitate the communication between the DJJ and the DCSO in regards to this agreement.
- Notify the DCSO, as soon as is reasonable, of any scheduling conflicts, dates and times the property or facilities will not be available to DCSO.


Termination of Agreement:

The DCSO understands the property and facilities involved in this agreement are currently for sale and that any sale or transfer of the property to a private or other governmental agency automatically terminates the terms of the agreement.

The DJJ may discontinue this memorandum of agreement, without cause, at any time by written notification being provided by the DJJ to the DCSO. This agreement remains in effect indefinitely until terminated by the DJJ.
