INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE CIRCUIT 2 AND THE STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE 2nd JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

This agreement is entered into as of the 10th day of 2011, between the Department of Juvenile Justice, Circuit 2, hereinafter referred to as the "Department" and the State Attorney's Office, 2nd Judicial Circuit, in response to Chapter 985.145(1)(j) which states "The State Attorney and the Department of Juvenile Justice, on a district-by-district basis, may enter into interagency agreements denoting the cases that will require a recommendation and those for which a recommendation is unnecessary."

The State Attorney's Office, 2nd Judicial Circuit, does not utilize the Department of Juvenile Justice recommendations in their filling decision process. In Leon County, the filling decisions are made without review of the Department of Juvenile Justice recommendation. In Jefferson, Liberty, Gadsden, Wakulla and Franklin Counties, filling decisions by the State Attorney are made before receipt of the Department of Juvenile Justice recommendation.

Therefore, effective the date of the signatures of this agreement, Circuit 2 will no longer complete State Attorney Recommendations. This agreement includes the Henry and Rilla White Foundation.

This AGREEMENT shall remain in effect for five (5) years unless modified sooner. Modification of this agreement shall be made only by the consent of both parties. Any party may withdraw as a party to this agreement upon giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
