**POLICY/PROCEDURE**

1. Dispositions reflect the legal status, state attorney decision, court order or other legal documentation.
2. Dispositions must be entered within 2 business days of disposition.
3. In order to enter a disposition, the referral must be assigned and the charge must have a court docket number.
4. The disposition date cannot be earlier than the referral date OR later than today.
5. JJIS only allows for PRIMARY and SECONDARY dispositions;
6. In rare circumstances a third disposition may be necessary, seek DIO assistance.

The following dispositions are available and determine the case type:

### **DEFINITIONS**

Disposition - the court's final determination of a lawsuit or criminal charge; a phase of delinquency proceeding similar to "sentencing" phase of adult trial.

Primary - first in order in any series, sequence, etc.; the first action taken by the SAO and/or Court

Secondary - not first in order of occurrence or development; dependent or consequent on another condition
